# Climadiff - 31 Bottle Freestanding Wine Cooler CS31B1

Climadiff are a French manufacturer of wine cabinets who have been producing their wine cabinets since the late 1990's, just after Eurocave started. They were amongst the first companies to enter into the industry and since then have developed a reputation for reliable and robust storage cabinets. Their focus is primarily on long term storage cabinets or ageing cabinets, however the CLS52 is part of the smaller freestanding range which is suitable for both service and storage.

### The Climadiff CS31B1

Part of the new freestanding range from Climadiff, the CS31B1 brings the latest technology and is very aesthetically pleasing with it's modern appearance and functionality.

The capacity of 31 Bordeaux bottles makes this unit ideal for customers who have smaller collections of 30 bottles or for those who want to use it for serving temperatures. the forced air cooling system the temperature inside the cooler is consistent and can be lit up with the internal LED lighting which is white. 3 metal shelves with a wooden front add to the modern design and enable sufficient access to your wines.

### Temperature range and efficiency

With a wide internal operating temperature of 5 to 20°C the CS31B1 can be used for both storage or service - combined with a low noise output of 42dB and with an A energy rating - this unit is also energy efficient.

### Freestanding wine cooler

The CS31B1 is a freestanding unit which means it shouldn't be installed under a counter top and should have a minimum clearance of 2-5 inches around the back and sides and at least 12 inches from above the unit to allow for adequate ventilation.

### Installation

### Freestanding Wine Cooler:

Freestanding wine coolers are designed to stand alone and not be built in to any cabinetry at all, we recommend a minimum ventilation space of 3-5 inches around the sides and rear of the unit. Do not install a freestanding unit under a counter top.

### *Built-in / undercounter wine cooler:*

A built in wine cooler is designed to be surrounded by cabinetry or can be utilised as a freestanding unit, this type of unit has a grille at the front to allow cool air to be drawn in.

### *Integrated Wine Cooler:*

Integrated wine cabinets are similar to built in wine coolers but are designed to slot into cupboards to create a floating look.

### Thermoelectric Wine Cooler:

Thermoelectric wine coolers should never be built into cabinetry or have the ventilation limited in any way. They are designed to sit on the floor or smaller units are perfect for installation on a counter top.
