

SWISSCAVE - 179 Bottle Single Temperature Zone Wine Cooler - WLB460F

SWISSCAVE built in or freestanding unit with a capacity of 179 Bordeaux bottles. Featuring a triple glazed UV resistant door with a black anodized handle, this unit looks great as a freestanding or when built into kitchen units.

With a wide operating temperature range of 5-20°C and dual temperature zones, this unit is perfect for use as a service wine cooler or if required, the WLB460F can be utilised as a long term storage unit for since it has a charcoal filter.

The new black edition units from Swisscave feature a Filigree precious black stainless steel frame rim with a lock. 14 Pull out beech shelves add a touch of class to the wine cooler and is something different in the wine cooler industry. The interior is also lit up by white LED's which are also mounted on the side walls to ensure you can see every layer of bottles easily.

The compressor is a highly efficient, high quality embraco compressor which can adjust the speed it is running at depending on the demand for cooler air in the cabinet - this makes the new Swisscave units highly efficient and really quiet in operation.

- Lockable door to ensure your wines are locked away, which is also reversible
- UV protected glass, preventing any UV light from entering the cabinet

What bottles will the WLB460F hold?

Swisscave products are designed around Bordeaux bottle of a length of up to 30-31cm and diameter of 7.5-8cm - if you plan on storing any larger bottles than a typical Bordeaux bottle you will either need to utilise the top and bottom shelves or the shelves are easy to remove. There is also the option to purchase additional 'Burgundy' shelves. If you are unsure as to whether your bottles you have will fit this unit - please get in touch.



Ventilation and Install requirements:

The WLB460F is designed as a front venting unit which means it can be used as a freestanding or a built in unit with cabinets built around it. If building cabinets around the wine cooler, it is best to leave 1cm to the rear of the unit and also bear in mind that the overhang on the Swisscave units is approximately 1.5cm - so to have the wine cooler sitting flush, this will need to be accounted for pre-purchase/installation.

Installation

Freestanding Wine Cooler:

Freestanding wine coolers are designed to stand alone and not be built in to any cabinetry at all, we recommend a minimum ventilation space of 3-5 inches around the sides and rear of the unit. Do not install a freestanding unit under a counter top.

Built-in / undercounter wine cooler:

A built in wine cooler is designed to be surrounded by cabinetry or can be utilised as a freestanding unit, this type of unit has a grille at the front to allow cool air to be drawn in.

Integrated Wine Cooler:

Integrated wine cabinets are similar to built in wine coolers but are designed to slot into cupboards to create a floating look.

Thermoelectric Wine Cooler:

Thermoelectric wine coolers should never be built into cabinetry or have the ventilation limited in any way. They are designed to sit on the floor or smaller units are perfect for installation on a counter top.
